COMMUNITY OVERVIEW

THE CITY OF FORT SCOTT OFFERS A HISTORIC DOWNTOWN, WHERE LIFE REVOLVES AROUND A TIGHT-KNIT COMMUNITY AND EVERYONE KNOWS THEIR NEIGHBORS. THE BRICK STREETS ARE LINED WITH QUAINt SHOPS, LOCAL EATERIES, AND BEAUTIFUL HISTORIC BUILDINGS THAT TELL STORIES OF THE PAST. COMMUNITY EVENTS—LIKE FARMERS' MARKETS, FESTIVALS, AND PARADES—BRING RESIDENTS TOGETHER, FOSTERING A STRONG SENSE OF BELONGING. FAMILIES OFTEN GATHER AT LOCAL PARKS, AND FRIENDSHIPS BLOSSOM OVER COFFEE AT COZY CAFES. WITH A SLOWER PACE OF LIFE AND A BUSTLING BUSINESS COMMUNITY, THIS TOWN OFFERS A SUPPORTIVE ATMOSPHERE WHERE LASTING MEMORIES ARE CREATED AMONG FRIENDS AND FAMILY. IT'S A PLACE WHERE HISTORY AND COMMUNITY SPIRIT INTERTWINE, MAKING IT FEEL LIKE HOME.

OUR PAST

FORT SCOTT, KANSAS, WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1842 AS A MILITARY OUTPOST TO PROTECT SETTLERS AND MAINTAIN ORDER IN THE REGION. ORIGINALLY PART OF THE INDIAN REMOVAL POLICIES, THE FORT PLAYED A CRITICAL ROLE IN THE TURBULENT YEARS LEADING UP TO THE CIVIL WAR. IT WAS A BASE FOR UNION TROOPS DURING THE WAR AND WITNESSED SIGNIFICANT EVENTS, INCLUDING SKIRMISHES AND TROOP MOVEMENTS.

AFTER THE WAR, FORT SCOTT TRANSITIONED INTO A CIVILIAN COMMUNITY. THE ARRIVAL OF THE RAILROAD IN THE LATE 1800S SPURRED GROWTH, AND THE TOWN DEVELOPED A THRIVING ECONOMY CENTERED ON AGRICULTURE AND TRADE. MANY HISTORIC BUILDINGS FROM THIS PERIOD STILL STAND TODAY, CONTRIBUTING TO THE CITY'S CHARM. IN THE 20TH CENTURY, FORT SCOTT CONTINUED TO EVOLVE, BUT ITS HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE REMAINED A FOCAL POINT.

FORT SCOTT TODAY

TODAY, THE CITY FEATURES A CHARMING DOWNTOWN AREA WITH ANTIQUE SHOPS, LOCAL EATERIES, AND SMALL COFFEE SHOPS. IT CELEBRATES ITS HERITAGE THROUGH VARIOUS EVENTS AND MAINTAINS THE FORT SCOTT NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE, ITS LOCATION ALONG HWY 69 MAKES IT A CONVENIENT STOP FOR TRAVELERS EXPLORING SOUTHEASTERN KANSAS. FORT SCOTT ALSO HOSTS VARIOUS FESTIVALS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR, HIGHLIGHTING ITS COMMUNITY SPIRIT AND HERITAGE. WHILE ATTRACTING VISITORS INTERESTED IN ITS RICH HISTORY.



TESTING DAY

AS PART OF OUR COMMUNITY'S SAFETY MEASURES, WE WANT TO INFORM YOU ABOUT THE TORNADO TESTING SIRENS USED IN OUR AREA. THESE SIRENS ARE TESTED MONTHLY, DURING THE MONTHS OF FEBRUARY THROUGH SEPTEMBER. TESTING IS ON THE FIRST AND THIRD TUESDAY OF EACH MONTH AT 1 PM.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- **MONTHLY TESTS:** SIRENS WILL SOUND DURING THE SCHEDULED TEST.
- **EMERGENCY ALERTS:** IF YOU HEAR THE SIREN OUTSIDE OF THE TESTING SCHEDULE, IT INDICATES A POTENTIAL TORNADO OR SEVERE WEATHER ALERT. IN SUCH CASES, SEEK SHELTER IMMEDIATELY AND TUNE IN TO LOCAL NEWS OR WEATHER SERVICES FOR UPDATES.

DOGS WELCOME

THE REGISTRATION OF DOGS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS IS REQUIRED ANNUALLY BY CITY ORDINANCE. ALL REGISTRATIONS EXPIRE ON THE LAST DAY OF MAY IN EACH YEAR. A CURRENT CERTIFICATE OF VACCINATION FOR RABIES MUST BE PROVIDED UPON REGISTRATION. DOGS CAN BE REGISTERED AT 123 S. MAIN ST.

FEES FOR THE REGISTRATION OF A NEUTERED MALE DOG OR SPAYED FEMALE DOG. THE FEE IS \$3.

FOR THOSE DOGS THAT ARE NOT NEUTERED OR SPAYED. THE FEE IS \$5.

VERIFICATION FROM YOUR VETERINARIAN THAT THE DOG HAS BEEN SPAYED OR NEUTERED IS ALSO REQUIRED PRIOR TO OBTAINING A TAG.

SEASONAL INSITES

AVERAGE WEATHER TEMPATURE

WINTER (DEC-FEB):
AVERAGE HIGHS ARE AROUND 40-50°F, WHILE LOWS CAN DROP TO THE 20S°F.

SPRING (MAR-MAY):
TEMPERATURES BEGIN TO WARM UP, WITH HIGHS RANGING FROM 55°F (13°C) IN MARCH TO 75°F IN MAY. LOWS ARE GENERALLY IN THE 30S TO 50S°F.

SUMMER (JUN-AUG):
THIS SEASON CAN BE HOT, WITH AVERAGE HIGHS OFTEN REACHING THE 80S AND 90S°F. LOWS ARE TYPICALLY IN THE 60S°F.

FALL (SEP-NOV):
TEMPERATURES START TO COOL DOWN, WITH HIGHS FROM THE UPPER 70S°F IN SEPTEMBER TO THE 50S°F IN NOVEMBER. LOWS DROP TO THE 30S AND 40S°F.

GUNN PARK IS A 155-ACRE PARK THAT HAS 7 SHELTER HOUSES 4 ENCLOSED AND 3 OPEN. TWO LAKES FOR FISHING AND MULTIPLE PLAYGROUND AREAS. THERE ARE 14 CAMPING SITES AVAILABLE WITH ELECTRICITY AND WATER. FROM OCTOBER 15 TO APRIL 15, FERN LAKE IS STOCKED WITH TROUT.

APPROXIMATELY, 6.5 MILES OF SINGLE TRACK, MOUNTAIN BIKE TRAILS HAVE BEEN ADDED IN THE TIMBER, AND ALONG THE MARMATON RIVER. THESE TRAILS PROVIDE ADVENTURE AND EXERCISE FOR MOUNTAIN BIKE RIDERS, TRAIL RUNNERS AS WELL AS HIKERS.


